## **Create an attractive and vibrant town centre**

- Enhance the street with improvements that retain the existing character as a picturesque heritage town characterised by large shady trees, quaint local shops with a strong community feel
- Create a central space for people to gather and come together for events
- Create places to sit, relax and enjoy the atmosphere and character of the traditional main street
- Support the enjoyment of the street with more essentials like seating, drinking fountains, rubbish bins, dog leash posts and water bowls
- More planting of shady street trees and gardens in keeping with the current planting palette
- Add vibrancy and interest with artworks and interpretive elements that reverence Woombye's heritage
- Encourage outdoor dining to support local businesses.

## **Improve pedestrian connectivity and experience**

- Create a cool, shady and green street that connects the western end of town to the central shops
- Create pedestrian friendly street by improving footpaths, making it easier to cross the street, slowing traffic and improving wheelchair access
- Improve pedestrian connectivity by providing new pedestrian crossings and improving safety at existing crossings.

## **Provide convenient car parking**

- Provide parking that is convenient and available close to shops
- Investigate parking duration times along Blackall Street.
